<p>*Rinse, discard caps &amp; lids *Labels may remain *Sort by color (blue bottles go in with green glass)</p> <p><b>*NO ceramics, light bulbs, window glass, lab glass, plates, drinking glasses, beer mugs, etc.</b></p>	<p>*Rinse out all food *Include aluminum foil &amp; pie pans, <b>empty</b> aerosol cans (without lids) and <b>empty</b> paint cans</p> <p><b>*NO food residue, scrap metal, siding, pots, pans, chair legs, etc.</b></p>	<p>*Rinse *Flatten *Plastic can be recycled if the body is wider than the neck</p> <p><b>*NO margarine tubs, yogurt cups, cottage cheese containers or plastic cups</b></p> <p><b>*NO buckets or plastic bags, please</b></p>

<p>*Includes newspaper, brown grocery bags, telephone books, junk mail, office paper, shredded paper (must be bagged), magazines, catalogs and paperboard products.</p> <p>*Inserts may remain</p> <p><b>*NO wet or yellowed newspaper, blue prints or carbon paper</b></p> <p><b>*NO plastic bags (except for shredded paper)</b></p>
